**Policy Title** Niacin Extended-Release/Simvastatin (Simcor®)

**Policy**

**Niacin extended-release/simvastatin (Simcor®)** is indicated as an adjunct to diet to reduce total-C, LDL-C, Apo B, non-HDL-C, or TG or to increase HDL-C in patients with primary hypercholesterolemia and mixed dyslipidemia (Fredrickson type IIa and IIb) when treatment with simvastatin monotherapy or niacin extended-release monotherapy is considered inadequate. Niacin extended-release/simvastatin (Simcor®) is also indicated to reduce TG in patients with hypertriglyceridemia (Fredrickson type IV hyperlipidemia) when treatment with simvastatin monotherapy or niacin extended-release monotherapy is considered inadequate.

The use of niacin extended-release/simvastatin (Simcor®) requires prior authorization (ie, clinical pharmacy and/or Medical Director review).

**Policy Description**

**Niacin extended-release/simvastatin (Simcor®)** is a combination of available existing agents, niacin extended-release and simvastatin. Niacin is a B-complex vitamin that has antihyperlipidemic effects, although the precise mechanism of action is unknown. Niacin may inhibit the release of free fatty acids from adipose tissue and increase lipoprotein lipase activity. Niacin increases high-density lipoprotein (HDL) and reduces triglycerides, total cholesterol, and LDL. Simvastatin is a lipid-lowering agent classified as an HMG-CoA Reductase Inhibitor. Simvastatin inhibits 3-hydroxy-3-methylglutaryl-coenzyme A (HMG-CoA) reductase, the enzyme that catalyzes the conversion of HMG-CoA to mevalonate. This conversion to mevalonate is an early and rate-limiting step in the biosynthesis of cholesterol.

**Policy Guideline Inclusion**

**Niacin extended-release/simvastatin (Simcor®)** is approved when the following inclusion criterion is met:

- Documentation of a trial of concurrent use of a prescription niacin product and a simvastatin-containing product

**Policy Guideline Exclusion**

**Niacin extended-release/simvastatin (Simcor®)** is denied when the following exclusion criterion is present:

- No documentation of a trial of concurrent use of a prescription niacin product and a simvastatin-containing product
