## Your eye health matters, and IBX vision benefits have you covered

Regular eye exams do more than check your vision. They can detect early signs of serious health conditions like diabetes, cardiovascular disease, and glaucoma.

Independence Blue Cross (IBX) members have access to comprehensive vision care coverage, including regular vision exams and services like:

- Dilation to check for eye diseases and other health problems.
- Refraction to determine a prescription for corrective lenses or contacts.
- Screening to prevent glaucoma, which causes vision loss if it's not treated.

## Affordable eyewear options

Need glasses? Your vision plan has a frame allowance. Use your frame allowance<sup>1</sup> and save on a wide selection of designer frames by choosing from one of the following options:

- Get an enhanced frame allowance when you shop at preferred sites.<sup>2</sup>
- Choose from no- to low-copay designer frames from the Davis Vision Exclusive Collection, available at many in-network retailers.
- Use your plan's frame allowance for frames at independent or retail providers in the Davis Vision network.

- **Fixed pricing and breakage warranty:** Your vision benefits include fixed pricing on all lens styles and coatings and a one-year breakage warranty on frames and lenses.
- **Discounted services on lens options:**
  - Anti-reflective coating — standard/premium/ultra/ultimate
  - Photosensitive/photochromic plastic/transition — single vision/multi-focal polycarbonate for children and adults; progressive additional multi-focal — standard/premium/ultra/ultimate
  - Ultraviolet (UV) coating
- **Second-pair discount:** If you select non-covered materials (e.g., a second pair of eyeglasses or sunglasses), you'll get a discount on a second pair — up to 50% off at preferred sites and 20% off at other participating in-network providers.

## Contacts and laser vision correction

Prefer contacts? Use your vision benefit for contact lenses instead of glasses at any in-network provider. You can also get up to 25% off on LASIK laser vision correction services at participating eye care professional locations.<sup>3</sup>

## Find in-network vision providers

The national Davis Vision network has more than **222,000 points of access** and **31,248 unique vision providers** to help you get care, where and how you want to.

- **Major retail chains**, including Visionworks, Warby Parker, Target Optical, LensCrafters, and Pearle Vision<sup>4</sup>
