

Estimate your costs for care



Use our **Care Cost Estimator** to save money on care, make informed decisions when choosing a provider, and avoid unplanned expenses.

Before you schedule your next visit or procedure, use the Care Cost Estimator. You can compare in-network providers side-by-side and estimate what you will pay for medical services based on your specific health plan.

The tool will display:



Your estimated out-of-pocket costs for a medical service



Provider details, such as practice locations, affiliated hospitals, and languages spoken



Quality information about each provider, such as member reviews

Higher cost doesn't always mean better care

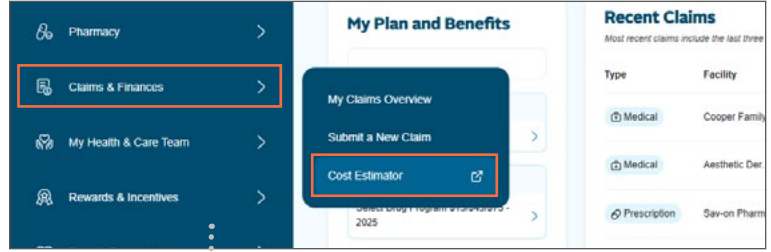
We want to make sure you know your options and can make informed decisions about your care.

Did you know? Certain factors like the setting where you receive care can affect the cost of medical services, such as common surgeries, X-rays, and MRIs.

For example, getting an X-ray at a hospital can cost twice as much as getting one at a local imaging center. And the more expensive a medical service is, the more you could be responsible for paying out of your own pocket.

Get started with the Care Cost Estimator

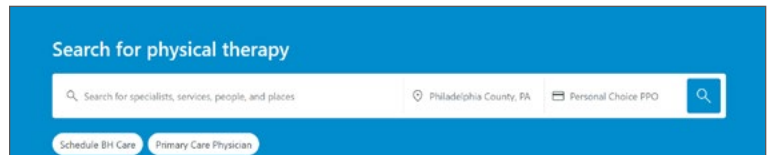
1 Log in at ibx.com and select *Cost Estimator* from the *Claims & Finances* menu on the left side of your Dashboard. A new window will open.



You can also click the *Medical* link under *Estimate your costs*.



2 Type the name of a practitioner, facility, practice, or service. This will populate results that fit your criteria within a 25-mile radius and that are specific to your health plan.



3 Search results display your out-of-pocket costs by provider. To view additional details about the cost, click on the *More Details* link below the estimated cost.



4 Click the *Compare* box in the lower left corner of each search result for providers and locations you want to look at side-by-side. Use this information to decide which provider is best for your health needs and budget.
